Combined Tests:

Class B: USEA 2009 Preliminary Test A, 3'7" show jumping

Class C: USEA 2009 Training Test A, 3'3" show jumping

Class D: USEA 2009 Novice Test A, 2'11" show jumping

Class E: USEA 2009 Beginner Novice Test A, 2'6" show jumping

Class F: USEA 2009 Beginner Novice Test A, 2' show jumping

Derby Divisions: *must have minimum of 6 entries to run division

Starter Novice: USEA 2009 Beginner Novice Test B, 2' jump course may include logs, terrain changes, and optional water crossing.

Beginner Novice: USEA 2009 Beginner Novice Test B, 2'6" jump course may include logs, terrain changes, optional water crossing, gentle combinations, half-ditch, or low brush

Novice: USEA 2009 Novice Test B, 2'11" jump course may include logs, banks, mandatory water crossing, ditch, combinations, or brush

Training: USEA 2009 Training Test B, 3'3" jump course may include trakehner, banks, ditch, half-coffin, combinations, brush, banks in or out of water, or fences on changing terrain.

Non-refundable office fee: \$10

Percent Dressage: \$20/first test, \$15 each additional test

Combined Test: \$60

Derby: \$90
